The auction will close to initial bidders at 10 PM ET on the day of closing. **This means that if you have not bid on a lot before 10 PM ET, you may not bid on it after 10 PM ET.** There are two phases of bidding during this auction: 1) Normal bidding: Bids are taken up until 10 PM ET the night the auction closes. 2) 30-Minute Ending: On a lot-by-lot basis, starting at 10:00 PM ET, any person who has bid on the lot previously may continue to bid on that lot until there are no more bids for 30 minutes. We charge 1.5% of the total amount of the invoice for shipping insurance. All items will be shipped with signature required through UPS Ground unless other prior arrangements are made. There is no charge for pickups. ALL SALES ARE FINAL. NO RETURNS. **Note: For items that cannot be shipped by UPS (i.e., too large) clients are responsible for making their own arrangements to have their pieces shipped from Lelands’ offices.**

SALES TAX ON WINNING BIDS

We will collect and remit sales tax on items shipped to the following states: **Arizona, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Massachusetts, Maryland, Michigan, North Carolina, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Texas, and Washington.** Any customer picking up items in New Jersey will be charged New Jersey sales tax. **Sales Tax Exemption:** To qualify, a properly completed and signed resale certificate must be submitted and approved prior to purchase. **International:** Lelands is not responsible for customs, duties, brokerage, and/or similar charges on items shipped outside the United States.

We reserve the right to modify our sales tax policies at any time to comply with changes in applicable tax laws.

AUTHENTICITY

Lelands stands by the authenticity of everything it sells for a period of two years from the date of the auction. It is up to the client to verify authenticity within that period of time. However, Lelands and its agents will be the final determinant of the authenticity of each and every piece it sells. We are not bound by the opinion of grading services, outside authenticators, or so-called “experts.” Letters of authenticity are only available for those pieces where “LOA” is listed in the catalog copy. Otherwise, your invoice alone will serve as your letter of authenticity.

COPYRIGHT

Neither Lelands nor the consignor makes any representation that the purchaser of manuscript material, photographs, prints, or works of art will acquire any copyright or reproduction rights thereto.

FRAMED PIECES/AUTOGRAPH LOTS/MISSING ITEMS

FRAMED PIECES: Please be aware that you are bidding on the framed item and not the frame itself. We are not responsible for any damage to the frames themselves, and no refunds will be given due to damaged frames. Lelands makes a great effort to protect framed pieces while in our care and during the shipping process. Please note that we cannot guarantee any item can be removed from its frame without the risk of damage to either the item or the frame. **AUTOGRAPH LOTS:** Please note that autograph lots with multiple items may contain “Clubhouse” and/or “Secretarial” signatures.

MISSING ITEMS: Lelands is not liable for the cost of replacing any items that are not explicitly listed in the lot item description provided in the published catalog. In the event of any missing items that are listed in the lot description, Lelands’ liability is limited to the final winning bid of the lot divided by the number of items in that lot (example: \$10 limit of liability for a 100 item lot that sells for \$1,000).

PAYMENT

Payment is due within 14 days after notification. Any bidder who has not paid in full within 14 days, without having made prior arrangements for late payment will have future bidding privileges revoked. Personal checks are accepted but without prior credit terms, merchandise will be held until your check clears. This generally takes approximately seven (7) business days. The locale for all such arbitrations shall be New Jersey. In the event that any Claim needs to be litigated, the litigation shall be exclusively in the Courts of the State of New Jersey. The claimant expressly waives any right to a trial by jury. The prevailing party may be awarded reasonable attorneys’ fees and costs. Any Claim must be brought within two (2) years of the alleged breach, default or misrepresentation or the Claim is waived. After one (1) year has elapsed, Auctioneer’s maximum liability shall be limited to any commissions and fees Auctioneer earned on that lot.
